

Pastor's Corner

Last Sunday, the feast of the Epiphany, our Bishops designated National Migration Week. Our Bishops do that at this time of the year because the Holy Family migrated to Egypt and the Magi were moving in search of the real Good News. While we are all spiritual pilgrims in this world, some of us need to leave our native land behind to seek safety and a decent life.

It comes as no news to many of you that Immigration Reform is something I care deeply about because it affects the lives of many of our fellow parishioners. That is why I regularly mention it. Obviously, with refugees and migrants from the Middle East and Africa entering Europe, this issue is even more contentious there. But not only there. For instance Jordan, with a total population of 6.61 million, has 630,776 Syrians registered as refugees. This doesn't count the thousands of Palestinian refugees who have lived in Jordan for decades. Our country, comparatively, takes many fewer refugees and migrants. A comparable percentage for us would be over 39.5 million refugees and migrants. The current administration has restricted that even further.

In recent years much attention has been focused on unaccompanied children crossing our southern border. While that has abated, it continues to be an issue. While it is a very complicated reality, we can all agree to pray: Loving Father, in your infinite compassion, we seek your divine protection for refugee children who are often alone and afraid.

Provide solace to those who have been witnesses to violence and destruction,

who have lost parents, family, friends, home, and all they cherish due to war or persecution.

Comfort them in their sorrow, and bring help in their time of need.

Show mercy to unaccompanied migrant children, too, Lord.

Reunite them with their families and loved ones.

Guide those children who are strangers in a foreign land to a place of peace and safety.

Comfort them in their sorrow, and bring help in their time of need.

Show us how we might reach out to these precious and vulnerable children.

Open our hearts to migrant and refugee children in need,

so that we might see in them your own migrant Son.

Give us courage to stand up in their defense against those who would do them harm.

For this we pray through our Lord Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen.
