

#### Pastor's Corner

Wednesday is the anniversary of the Roe v Wade decision. For years this has been a special time of prayer for the legal protection of unborn children. I am sure that to say more than that is unnecessary and "preaching to the choir". Yet, it is important to "rally the troops", so to speak, as we continue to demand an end to abortion in this country. Wednesday's 8:00 am Mass will be prayed especially for this intention. It is also a time to ask forgiveness as a society. The origins of the Roe v Wade decision are found in our broader culture's insistence that individual freedom trumps communal responsibility.

The phrase, "A woman has a right to choose what to do with her own body" does not deny that another life is at stake. Rather, it claims that the individual's freedom trumps the responsibility for the other life in the womb. It also seems to me that the individualism that is so often lauded in our culture ("everyone needs to earn his own keep") keeps us from supporting, as we ought, women who choose life in a precarious situation. There is a societal cost to being pro-life.

Let us pray, as well, that pro-life people can be part of a broad coalition to support early childhood programs and nutrition and healthcare programs for all families. These kinds of social safety nets give a bit of security to poor women that their children will have a decent chance at a dignified life. For a woman in crisis, some security can make all the difference. Being Pro-Life has to mean more than just being Anti-Abortion. Unfortunately, it often happens that the politicians who identify themselves as "anti-abortion" are also against these programs that give hope to pregnant poor women.

So, in addition to asking for forgiveness, we also have reason to give thanks for women who choose life, for those in their families who support their decision (e.g. grandparents raising their children's children), and for all those who politically support pro-family programs. God bless you all.


