God answers all our needs.

Shepherd's Call

Three weeks ago, in my homily of July 12, I spoke about visiting friends and asking them to pray with me on a passage of Scripture. Now you have heard that passage, too. It was today's gospel in which Jesus was "moved with pity for the crowd" and responded by multiplying the loaves and the fish. That simple phrase "moved with pity" was an invitation for me to meditate on the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Oh, that I could learn so much more from his Most Sacred Heart! St. Jean Vianney – whose feast day is Tuesday of this week – said, "The priesthood is nothing less than the love of the Sacred Heart of Jesus." In the future, with the help of God's grace, I hope that I am able to live that more clearly for you.

On Monday, August 3 Fr. Rob Jack will interview me on *Driving Home the Faith* regarding my language immersion in Mexico. Fr. Rob Jack is a priest of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, and *Driving Home the Faith* is a program of Sacred Heart Radio (89.5 FM and 910 AM). In some ways it seems odd that I have not said more about my time there. Then I realize that I was only in the country for two weeks before the world shut down. At that point, the quarantine and the fallout from the quarantine dominated thought and discussion (and a sense of panic at facilitating online learning of young children). Anyway, hear me speak about my language immersion Monday at 4:30pm. I hope you will be understanding as to why I did not give you, my parishioners, the scoop before taking to the airwaves.

The parish pastoral councils for St. Julie's and St. Joseph will resume meeting in August. St. Peter in Chains pastoral council already has been meeting online in recent months. Visit the parish webpage to see minutes of recent meetings. Jesus, draw us closer to your Most Sacred Heart.

El consejo pastoral continuará reunirse este mes. Estoy agradecido a la pareja de la comunidad Hispana que sirve en esta capacidad; se necesito. Para lo que necesito considerar en el futuro, sería muy bueno que tenga uno o dos más miembros bilingües de la comunidad Hispana este año adelante.

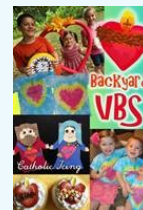
Oh, yes you can!

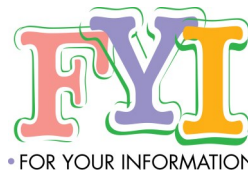
