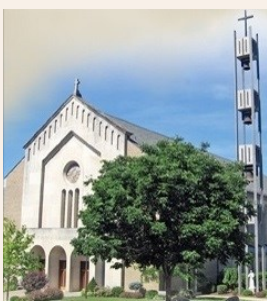

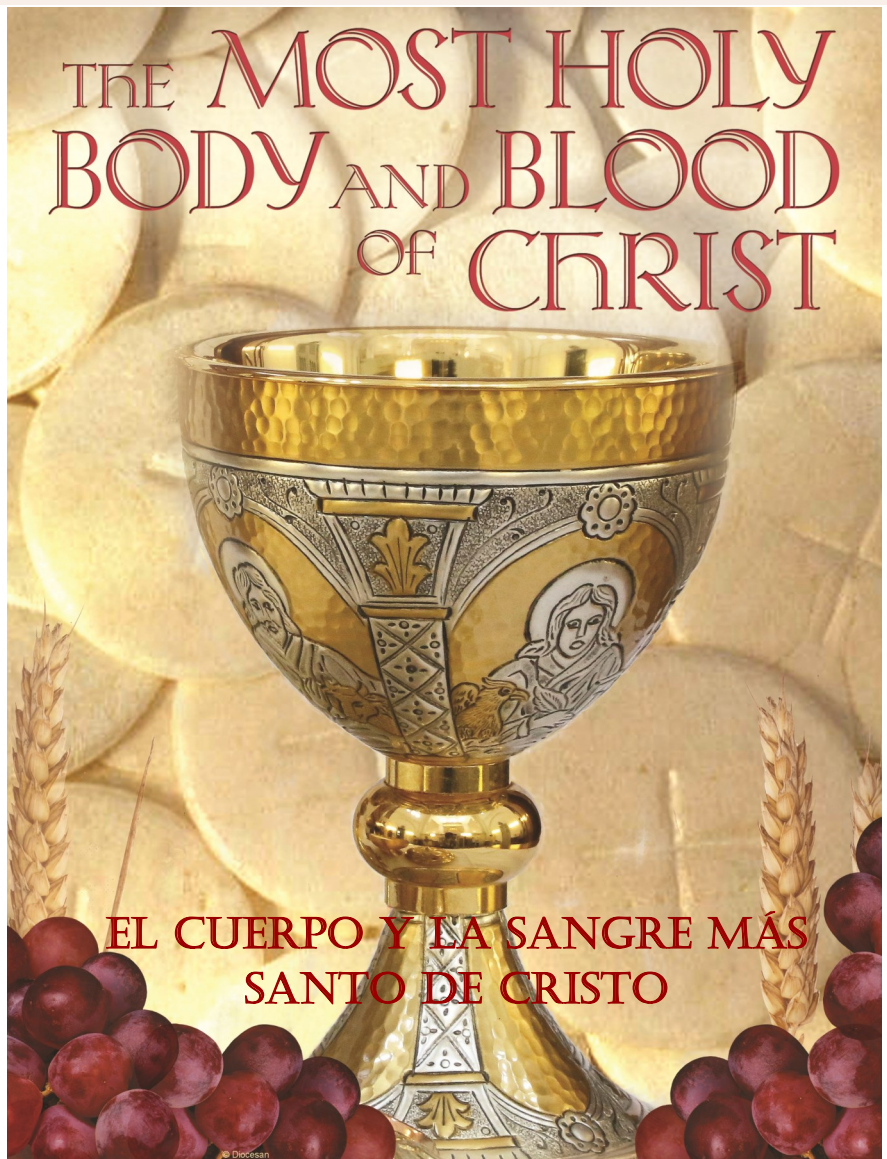

### Corpus Christi

Wow! What a beautiful prayer last night! It was beautiful to see members of all three parishes come together to pray with the pilgrim statue of Fatima. I have admiration for the pilgrims who are walking miles (literally miles) to share the graces that our Lady brings. It was a true celebration of diversity as lovers of God from both language groups lifted our prayers to Mary, Queen of Heaven.

This weekend is the celebration of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus. Jesus has given everything for us on the Cross. I refer to the Eucharist as God's greatest gift this side of heaven, since it is Jesus himself, given for us. I will be away on vacation beginning June 13, and I will return the following Saturday, June 19<sup>th</sup>.

### **PREP – Pastoral Region Religious Education Program**

Catholic Faith Formation is provided by catechists who are on fire with the love of Christ. On Sunday mornings we gather in the Fenmont Activity Building, September thru April each year. Children in grades K – 12 have classes that provide information and experiences to further their relationship with God. Sacramental preparation occurs for two years for First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation. Confirmation is celebrated every other year in our Pastoral Region. Our next Confirmation will be in 2023. We want children to learn about God every year, not just the year prior to a sacrament. Parents, Godparents, Grandparents, Aunts, Uncles, and friends are encouraged to enroll their children in PREP. SafeParish is an organization that specializes in training & education solutions for organizations worldwide. They have 20+ years of experience in providing child safe environment training programs. SafeParish will continue to work with our current background check provider Selection.com. All training and background information in your current VIRTUS account will be transferred to SafeParish. No new live training through SafeParish will be required if you have completed live child protection training through VIRTUS. Ongoing child protection training will still be required for all volunteers and employees & will consist of quarterly interactive video-based training instead of monthly bulletins. As the archdiocese moves closer to the conversion date, additional information regarding your new SafeParish account will be provided. ### **Pastoral Region Missionary Co-op Appeal Weekend of June 13**

Next weekend, June 13, at all masses, Rev. Raju Pilla & Rev. Lenin Raj will be speaking about the works and the needs of the Latin Archdiocese of Trivandrum in India. Trivandrum has about 270,000 Catholics. 90% of the people are traditional fishermen who depend on fishing for their livelihood and 10% are farm workers who are recent converts from low caste Hindus. Unemployment and poverty are most rampant in this community. The Archdiocese depends on outside assistance to support its clergy, seminarians, catechists and to continue its developmental programs. **However, during this pandemic triple lockdown the situation is very pathetic as the fishermen are restricted from fishing and fish-wending. With income halted from fishing the people are struggling to survive; local churches are stressed to support the most vulnerable. There is so much poverty in our villages! We are looking for some emergency food assistance.** Won’t you be as generous as you can in the special collection? Your sacrifice for the Missions is deeply appreciated.
