



WILL CHURCHES CLOSE AS A RESULT OF "BEACONS"?

Each Family of Parishes will begin by bringing parish staff and pastoral councils together. The pastor, staff and councils will discern Sunday Mass schedules and locations. The pastor and lay leaders will develop a plan for parish programs and activities with a long-term goal of becoming one community of faith. The disposition of all parish assets, including church buildings, will be decided within each Family of Parishes based on particular circumstances and opportunities. The expectation is that, over time, a Family of Parishes will become one canonical parish. With that expectation in mind, it is important to remember that a parish can be made up of a single church or multiple churches.

WILL FINANCIAL DONATIONS REMAIN WITH ONE'S CURRENT PARISH OR WILL IT GO TO ONE'S NEW FAMILY

UPON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF FAMILIES OF PARISHES THIS JULY?

Parishes will remain as individual juridic persons that retain money donated to them upon the implementation of Families of Parishes. Individual parish finances will remain separate and not be comingled with other parishes in the Family of Parishes unless that parish undergoes a canonical change i.e. is suppressed or notably altered.



Safe Parish - NEW QUARTERLY Bulletin for you to read was sent on Friday, March 25.

Quarterly Bulletins All volunteers and employees (unless otherwise exempted) are required to complete SafeParish quarterly child protection bulletins to remain compliant with the continuing education requirements of the Decree. All users will be notified when quarterly bulletins are issued and will have 30 days from the date of issue to complete the bulletin. Missing one quarterly bulletin will result in your account being non-approved and you will not be able to volunteer or work with youth. Missing 6 quarterly bulletins will require that you complete the SafeParish child protection training before your account will be approved. To complete your quarterly bulletin, go to the Training Tab and click on the 'Due' link to see which bulletins are due and their due date. To see Training sessions you have already taken, click on the 'Completed' link where you can see the training bulletin, the date it was completed.

"What is New at AoC SafeParish" emails This is an email which is sent out every Tuesday listing articles that are being posted on the www.aocsafeenvironment.org website. These articles are NOT mandatory reading but are encouraged as their content has valuable information regarding child protection. These articles do NOT replace the required quarterly bulletins. St. Julie Billiart - Feast Day, April 8—She was born on 12 July 1751, at Cuvilly, France, the sixth of seven children of Jean-François Billiat and Marie-Louise-Antoinette (née Debraine). By the age of seven, she knew the catechism by heart and used to gather her companions around her to hear her recite it and to explain it to them. Her education was confined to the rudiments obtained at the village school kept by her uncle, Thibault Guilbert. In spiritual things her progress was so rapid that the parish priest, Father Dangi court, allowed her to make her First Communion and to be confirmed aged 9. She took a vow of chastity five years later. She was held in very high esteem for her virtue and piety, and was commonly called, "the saint of Cuvilly". When twenty-two years old, a nervous shock, brought about by a pistol-shot fired at her father by an unknown enemy, brought on a paralysis of the lower limbs. Within a few years

she was confined to her bed and remained incapacitated for 30 years. During this time, when she received Holy Communion daily, Billiart exercised an uncommon gift of prayer, spending four or five hours a day in contemplation. The rest of her time was occupied in making linens and laces for the altar and in catechizing the village children whom she gathered around her bed, giving special attention to those who were preparing for their First Communion.

RCIA

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults and Children

This church ritual process of RCIA calls for adults and children 7 years and older to a conversion of mind and heart and prepares them for a full and active life in the church as disciples of Jesus. The culmination of that ritual process is the celebration of the Sacraments; Baptism, Eucharistic and Confirmation in the Easter Vigil.

For Whom is RCIA intended?

- For those who are unbaptized and preparing for sacraments of Baptism, Eucharistic and Confirmation.
- For those who are already Baptized but may be preparing for a profession of faith and full communion within the Roman Catholic Church.

MAY CROWNING & Procession at St. Julie will be on Sunday, May 15 at 10:15 am. We will begin at the Mary Garden on the side of church. First Communicants are asked to wear their special outfits and lead the procession. All are encouraged to come and pray this traditional way to honor Mary, the Mother of our Lord. 


