



#### Pastor's Corner

As we've announced previously next Saturday, May 21, Deacon Uriel Santos will be ordained a priest for the service of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. It may be that you think that "Beacons of Light" is about "rearranging the deck chairs on the Titanic". That would be very much off the mark. There are many positive signs for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. The ordination of Deacon Uriel and his six classmates is just one thing.

The slogan "From maintenance to mission" is not just so many words. It is THE PLAN. To reinvigorate the Church. Until July 1 our task, individually and as a "Family of Parishes" is to pray and educate ourselves. But, you might ask, how do we become a more "mission driven" Church? That is so general. There are six guiding principles: Eucharist, Church, Leadership, Steward, Evangelization, and Love in Action. An image in my mind is when the coach gets the team all fired up in the locker room and, with a final shout, sends them out to the court, only to find that the locker room door is locked. All charged up and nowhere to go.

So the principles give us an idea of how to use our energy. The Archdiocese is hiring a number of "facilitators" who will accompany each family in assessing where they are in each area, what their combined resources are, and what their interests are in each area. Then, the Family will begin to plan together to implement projects etc. in each area. This is over the course of at least five years.

And, for the first time, there is some accountability built into this project. Periodically, the Family will report to the Archdiocese how it is moving forward. This is far from just a reorganization of parishes!
