

A Message From Fr. Matt ...

Dear Brothers and Sisters.

Today is Gaudete Sunday, the Third Sunday of Advent. Gaudete means rejoice. Why should we rejoice? Good question.

In the Gospel today a question is asked: "Who are you?" Yep, another good question.

So let's look at each question separately and see if our Readings give us any answers. First, why should we rejoice? Think about your life. Is everything perfect? It has been just a perfect year, huh? The Steelers had a perfect year going but we know how that changed. How about you? How is your season going? If you are anything like me, you are not 11-1! I hope in your life you have had some good things happen this year, some things that caused you to rejoice. I sure have. But I bet you've had some tough stuff, too. I have had that also. But the Readings today lead us in another direction, away from introspection or reflection on our own lives. The Readings call us to rejoice not because of what is going on in our lives, but because of who our God is! Our God is good. Our God is faithful. Our God does great things for us. Our God is merciful and just. And, the reason for the pink...our God is near! Why rejoice? As we sang in today's Psalm: My soul rejoices in my God!



Isn't that something? That it isn't really about us at all. All of our stuff. All of our dreads. All of our worries. This isn't about that. It is about God. God who is near. God who has all of that stuff in His hands.

So let's look at the second question. Who are you? This question was asked to John the Baptist today. Look at how he answers. It is something that would be good for us to learn. When John the Baptist is asked, "Who are you?", he answers by telling them who he is not. He is not the Christ. He is not the Messiah. There is one and He is good, but he is not me. He is not you either. You are not the Savior. It doesn't all depend on you. The decision you make won't ruin everything forever. The weight of the world is not on your shoulders. Do you know why? Because you aren't the Christ! Neither is John the Baptist. Neither am I. Take a deep breath. Let that sink in a little. Unhook your shoulders from your ears! It is not all up to you. It is all up to Jesus and Jesus is really good at this saving the world thing. Let Him do His job.

So rejoice! It's not about you, but it is about a God who is all about you. Trust Him. Let Him work. Rejoice because of who you are not. You are not the Savior. We already have One and He is so good!



TODAY, THE CHURCH EMPHASIZES THE JOY IN OUR HEARTS AS WE AWAIT THE BIRTH OF OUR SAVIOR. THE GREAT JOY OF CHRISTIANS IS TO SEE THE DAY WHEN THE LORD WILL COME AGAIN IN HIS GLORY TO LEAD THEM INTO HIS KINGDOM. THE OFT-REPEATED VENI ("COME") OF ADVENT IS AN ECHO NOT ONLY OF THE PROPHETS BUT ALSO OF THE CONCLUSION OF THE APOCALYPSE OF ST. JOHN: "COME, LORD JESUS," THE LAST WORDS OF THE NEW TESTAMENT.
