




A Message from Fr. Matt ...

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Do you know how much God loves you?

Our beautiful Readings today tell us just how much. In the First Reading we see Abraham put to the test. God asks Abraham to sacrifice his beloved son Isaac. But then God stops him. God had seen Abraham's faith. God sees that Abraham knows how much God loves him. That was enough.



But God doesn't stop there. In the Second Reading we are reminded that God did spare Abraham's beloved son, but God did not spare His own beloved Son, Jesus. But God doesn't stop there. Not only did God sacrifice His beloved Son for us, but Jesus rose from the dead, unlocked the gates of Heaven and now prays for us! He died for us. He rose for us. He prays for us.

Do you know how much God loves you?

God does all of this because He loves you and wants to be with you forever in Heaven. Oh man, does He love you! Do you believe it? Do you think you're worth it?

Before you start thinking of all of the reasons why you're unworthy of God's love, let me tell you who believes that you are deserving. God does. And let me tell you who believes that you are not worthy of God's love. Satan. Satan thinks it is ridiculous that God would lower Himself to love you like He does. Satan can see us. He knows what we do and say, what we are like. But here is where Satan gets it wrong. He thinks this is all about you. It isn't. This is all about God.

The thing is, this God, who it's all about, is all about you. There is no way that we could make ourselves worthy of God's love. Nothing we give up could ever earn God's love. But this isn't about us. It is about God who is for us, and all about us. Satan wants us to be wrapped up in questions and self concern, like the disciples in the Gospel after Jesus tells them what He is going to do. They were confused, even terrified. But God says that we don't need to be trapped in self concern, worries about our status, our grievances against each other, our doubts and fears. He will take those on for us. He will die for us. He will rise for us. He will pray for us at the right hand of the Father. Jesus will do it! He will do it not because of what you have done, but because He loves you first. God is all about you, so you don't need to be.

This week, focus on the fact that God loves you. You are worthy of God's love because God decided you are. No other reason. Just sit with that thought each day this week and be grateful.



FRIDAYS OF LENT DAYS OF ABSTINENCE

Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. The obligation of abstinence (refraining from eating meat) begins at age 14. The law of fasting (limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals) is for individuals ages 18-59 who are without a medical condition in which fasting may be considered harmful. If you cannot fast, almsgiving is suggested. Fasting is obligated on Good Friday.

Easter is always the Sunday after the full moon that occurs on or after the Spring Equinox on March 21st. This full moon may happen on any day between March 21 and April 18. If the full moon happens on a Sunday, Easter will be the Sunday following. Easter cannot be earlier than March 22 or later than April 25.
