

Portiuncula Indulgence

The Portiuncula is a little town situated near Assisi. It was here that St. Francis of Assisi recognized his vocation. The Portiuncula indulgence could originally be gained only in the Portiuncula between the afternoon of August 1st and sunset on August 2nd. The present disciplines for the faithful to gain a plenary indulgence applicable to themselves or the souls in purgatory are from noon on August 1st until midnight on August 2nd:

- Be in a state of grace.
- Confession (8 days before or after).
- Holy Communion.
- Prayers for the intentions of the Pope

The exaltation of the Church

The propagation of faith

The extirpation of sinners

The conversion of sinners

Concord between Christian princes

All other goods of the Christian people

 Visit a cathedral, parochial, quasi-parochial or Franciscan church and praying at least one Our Father & one Creed.

It is also necessary to have the intention of gaining the indulgence and be detached from all affection to sin, even venial.


