

A Message from Fr. Matt...

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In the Gospel this week, Jesus invites his Apostles, who have just returned from their first missionary journey, to "come away by yourselves, to a deserted place, and rest for a while." That sounds so good doesn't it? Man I could use something like that. I bet you could too. We all need a break from time to time don't we?

Actually, I am going away next weekend. But I am not going to a deserted place and I don't know if it will be totally restful! My nephew Matt is getting married in Philadelphia next weekend. So I will start there and then go to the beach in Delaware for a while. Matt is a great kid. He is named after me, so he better be, right? He is a counselor for young people who have messed up and gotten in some trouble. He is already a great dad and will be a great husband. I'm very excited to be with Matt and Danielle as they get married and to celebrate with my family. Will it be restful? I don't know about that!

Isn't that the way it often is though? It's good to get away, no matter how far, just to change the scenery. Just being somewhere away, whether it's at camp or with friends, or at the beach, the lake or the river, can give us peace and a little rest. But it often takes so much organization, packing, planning, shopping, making sure that everything is taken

care of while we are away, that we miss the "getting rest" part. When the change of place itself isn't enough to get you to let go, rest and get peace. Some people try to drink or smoke themselves to a place of rest and peace. That never fully works though does it?

So how do we get the rest and peace that we need in our lives?

Here's a question for you. What if our rest, our peace wasn't a different place, or a different drink, or an amount of sleep, but was a person? What if it was Jesus? I think that is what our readings are telling us today.

In the Gospel, Jesus takes his disciples away to a deserted place. The crowd follows. But the disciples find rest, even though the crowds are still there, because Jesus is there too and Jesus ministers to them. Jesus is the Good Shepherd prophesied in the First Reading, who leads His flock to the rich meadow. Jesus is the restful water in the Psalm. Jesus is our Peace as St. Paul says in the Second Reading.



What the Lord is telling us is that even if you can't get away this year, or if getting away makes you more frazzled and tired than before you left, you can come away and rest a while with Him. It isn't so much about a place, an activity or an amount consumed. It is about a person. A person who is not just a historical figure, but who is alive. It is about Jesus. He is our peace. When we talk to Him, like a real person, and share our lives, our joys, our sorrows and our struggles with Him, we will find restful waters. We will find gentle meadows. We will find peace.

So the challenge this week is to go away for a while. Go on vacation! You don't need to go anywhere different. Just invite Jesus into your life. Share what is going on. Speak to Him like a real person, because He is one. Come away and rest a while with Jesus. Let Him be your vacation. Let Jesus be your peace.

ARE YOU INTERESTED IN BECOMING A CATHOLIC? RCIA SESSIONS TO BEGIN IN SEPTEMBER



Why Be A Catechist at This Time?

In today's reading Jesus invites his disciples to REST after their ministry, and Jesus is moved with pity for the crowds who pursue them. We read how upon the return of the disciples, who were sent by Jesus to preach repentance, drive out demons, and heal the



sick, that the people want more from them. Jesus invites the disciples to come away from the crowd and get REST with him.

This Scripture speaks to us in so many ways about what it means to be in ministry. But the word REST is speaking to me right now. Maybe because I am on vacation at a beach and enjoying God's creation. You may be thinking she just got here, why does she need vacation. All of us just experienced an intense year and a half of uncertainty, unexpected changes, and some workloads that didn't get lighter, but tripled. I don't complain about that, in fact, it was humbling and amazing. It is amazing what we can do in the thick of it when sharing the faith is the focus. Jesus inviting his disciples to REST with him is exactly what we should be doing right now as Catechists. We recharge our own spiritual lives to be better equipped and ready for the fall formation of the children of our parish community. It is innate in the children of our programs to seek something greater. They don't realize that it is a need, a longing just like the people of today's Scripture. It is our responsibility to provide them with what they need to grow in their faith and relationship with God.
