

A Message from Fr. Matt

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

All of our Readings for this week show us situations that are difficult, frustrating or even embarrassing.

In the First Reading, the Prophet Ezekiel is sent by God to the Israelites. While Ezekiel is strengthened by the Spirit, God tells him that it won't be easy. Israel is a rebellious people who have revolted against God. "Hard of face and obstinate of heart are they to whom I am sending you" God tells Ezekiel. But just go anyway and tell them I sent you! Sheesh! That doesn't sound like its going to go well.

In the Second Reading, St. Paul talks about the struggles that he has had. "A thorn in the flesh", Paul calls it. Three times Paul has asked God to remove it, but each time, God has said no. He knows that Paul is struggling but God also says that His Grace will be enough. So keep suffering Paul, trust that I've got this, God seems to say.

In the Gospel, Jesus goes home to Nazareth, but everyone there is ticked off at Him. They know Him, they say. He isn't all that. All of the amazing things that Jesus did in other places, healing, cleansing, raising people from the dead, He could not do in His hometown, because the people there thought they had Him all figured out and that He wasn't anything special.

Three tough situations. I bet each of us can feel a connection to one of them at least. Maybe all three. So what is the solution? What does the Scripture tell us? How do we keep going when we are misunderstood, embarrassed, hurting, feeling unheard by God, or facing people who won't respect or accept us?

St. Paul gives us the remedy. Be small. Be weak. Let God be strong in you.

Our two Patrons, St. Francis and St. Clare are great examples of this way of living. Francis and Clare founded what has become the largest religious order in the world! Yet they always thought of themselves as small. They were "Little Mirrors", reflecting Jesus to others. They were only able to reflect Him because they stayed out of the way. They made themselves small, poor and weak so that Christ could be exalted rather than them. St. Paul says, "I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships...for the sake of Christ, for when I am weak, I am strong."



This week, we have a tough challenge. When you face tough stuff, arguments, anger, misunderstanding, when people don't respect you or treat you poorly, when you feel like God isn't listening to your prayers, don't be embittered, don't complain about it. But don't give up. Be little. Be small. Be weak. Get yourself out of the way and be a little mirror for Christ. Let Jesus be strong in you and for you. This is the remedy. This is the way through.



Catholic Identity Program


This program highlights a variety of virtues and values through short lessons, prayers, and Scripture references.
