FORERUNNER DAY ASSIGNMENTS

Freshmen Forerunner Days will begin at 9:00 AM and will last until 12:00 PM; this day will be an opportunity to meet members of your class, a chance to learn about life at SJB, and a time to participate in other fun activities. You will need to provide your own transportation on this day. Please use the South Lobby entrance (back of the school by the athletic fields).
