FRESHMAN FORERUNNER DAY

This day is an opportunity to meet members of your class, a chance to learn about life at SJB, and a time to participate in other fun activities. Please note that in order to comply with social distancing protocols, <u>Freshmen are only permitted to attend on their assigned date</u>. A virtual Forerunner Day will be posted to the school website on Friday, September 4 at 10:00AM for all students who are unable to attend this event in person.

Forerunner Days run from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. All Freshmen need to provide their own transportation to this event. Please get dropped off at the building's South Lobby Entrance (back of the school by the athletic fields). The dress code is casual (t-shirt, shorts, sneakers or flip flops are all fine), but your appearance should be neat and appropriate for school. All participants will also be required to wear a face mask during the entire day's activities.

Only Freshman students who are scheduled for the Forerunner Day will be permitted to enter the school. No other individuals (parents, relatives, siblings) will be allowed in the building at any point during the day's program.

FRESHMAN ORIENTATION

The Class of 2024 will be divided into the following two groups for the "first official day of school":

The day will begin at 7:50 a.m. and students will depart at 12:00 p.m. Local districts should provide busing, but it is advisable to contact them to confirm this. School issued Chromebooks will be distributed to all Freshmen who have completed the Technology Use and Behavior Policy form.

Students with last names A-L should pick them up on Thursday, September 10, and students with last names M-Z should pick them up on Friday, September 11.
