In the book *Tuesdays with Morrie*, Morrie teaches Mitch Albom thirteen life lessons. For example, “The Third Tuesday: *We Talk About Regrets.*” In each of these lessons, Morrie states a claim and then proceeds to support it.

The bullet points listed below are what is required in your response.

I am sure you remember practicing for the Regents, a good argument has a claim that is supported by evidence and includes commentary.

- Choose **FIVE** Tuesdays that Mitch spent with Morrie.
- Identify the claim in each lesson and choose **one** specific piece of evidence from that Tuesday lesson that supports the claim.

CLAIM-----Evidence-----Commentary

What is commentary? Commentary is your thought process on how that evidence supports the claim being made. It is your reasoning and your proof that your answer is valid.

- **Once you establish the Claim, Evidence, and Commentary, then, in your opinion, was the claim and evidence Morrie used effective or not effective. A simple yes or no will not be accepted. Be sure to support your reasoning.**

Each of the five claims will be worth 25 points.
