I. AWARD

Scholarships awarded will be in the amount of \$2000 and will be sent directly to the student's college or university account. Awardees may also apply for an additional \$1000 second-year scholarship to be applied to the student's account in the second year.

II. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible any graduating high school senior must have been accepted by an accredited university or college as a full-time student and meet at least **one of the following additional qualifications**. Be <u>either</u>

- A member of Saint Joseph Parish
- Or the child or grandchild of a member of Council 11759 in good standing without regard to residence

Or the child or grandchild of a deceased member of Council 11759 who was in good standing at the time of his death without regard to residence



Eligibility for the **second-year scholarship** is proof of enrollment and a minimum 2.0 grade point average in the first year.

III. SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants for a Knights of Columbus Scholarship shall be judged on the basis of financial need, academic achievement, academic potential, academic honors, and extra-curricular activities (School, Community, and Church.)

To be considered for a scholarship, a graduating high school senior must:

- Complete the <u>current (2024-2025 academic year)</u> prescribed application, answering all questions.
- 2. Attach a *certified* transcript of his or her high school grades.
- 3. Include a copy of a <u>letter of acceptance</u> from the college or university. If an acceptance letter is not available at the time of application, the Council must receive a copy of the letter of acceptance before making an award.
- 4. All documentation must reach the Committee not later than the announced deadline for application. *Each applicant is responsible to see that the application reaches the Church Office by the deadline. There will be no exceptions!*
