Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6 pm with an opening prayer led by Fr. Brian.

Reflections on Pastoral Council Listening Conversations

Desired Outcome: Provide feedback to Fr. Brian and the council about the experiences of our parishioners and guests at St. Joseph. Share key insights: good news, challenges, and movements of the Holy Spirit. Share parish experiences with the priest and understand parish dynamics.

- Reflections from Walking with Purpose: women feel welcome, they like the
 increased activities promoted by St. Joseph's Church. They requested more
 evening events for those with work responsibilities during the day. Suggestions
 offered included a table with information about how to connect, along with a
 place for children to leave their artwork. Members suggested that children be
 encouraged to place their artwork in the offertory baskets.
- One member invited a colleague to attend Stations of the Cross; this was well received.
- Members reflected on their experience with the door-to-door ministry (e.g., praying with a resident who was struggling with drug addiction and another who was diagnosed with cancer).

Refining our Listening

Desired Outcome: Improve our pastoral listening approach

Members asked for more than one minute before mass begins to have conversations with other parishioners, or to have more opportunity for interactions. Other thoughts included recruiting more individuals to listen and invite.

Parish and School Updates

Goal: Ensure the council is informed to listen effectively.

Father Brian updated council members on the following activities:

- Liturgical ministry retreat
- Ministry leader summit
- Liturgical minister (Lexi Davis, start 8/1/25)
- Easter vigil included 11 baptisms
- All the liturgies were well attended
- ELC now has 65 children with plans to open another baby room.
- Regarding finances there was an increase noted after the offertory campaign.
- Significant number of individuals coming to confession before Easter

Nominations Committee

Goal: Progress toward 12 members by March 19th

Nominations committee presented their recommendations for three additional PC members: Jen Norris, Dave Cochran, and Tim Michl. The council members unanimously agreed with their recommendations and Fr. Brian confirmed his concurrence. New members will be intentionally on-boarded by current members to welcome them and give them background on the council's activities.
