December 6, 2020 Second Sunday of Advent

Isaiah 40:1-5, 9-11; 2 Peter 3:8-14; Mark 1:1-8

In today's jargon John the Baptist was a "hot ticket" item. Folks from the countryside and from the big city were flocking to see and hear him.

But when they got there, what did they see? No one glamorous, that's for sure. There were no strobe lights and 30 ft. high speakers surrounding John. No glitz, no hype, no glimmer. Just John—in a camel hair suit.

Maybe it was his very difference that drew people to him. Maybe it was his message as well— "get ready, prepare, repent! Something is coming! Someone is coming! You need to change and get ready!"

As a sign of that readiness people were baptized in the Jordan, and in some manner or other "confessed their sins." They were readying themselves to welcome "good news."

We look back on John today as a rather puzzling, even strange figure. We may get stuck on his appearance, his odd eating habits, his solitary style, and fail to hear his message. That message is as relevant now as it was then: we need to open our minds and hearts, we need to look at our lives, that may contain sin, and repent. The one who follows John cannot be received by unready hearts.

Trust the past to God's mercy, the present to God's love and the future to God's providence.
