Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jonah 3:1-5, 10; 1 Corinthians 7:29-31; Mark 1:14-20

God's ways of dealing with us take unpredictable turns more often than not. About the time we've settled into a nice pattern of behavior—usually rather tame—God comes along and upsets the apple cart.

The Virus, natural disasters, politics, etc. have turned our lives around in major ways.

To "turn around," to "look anew," to have a "change of heart and perspective". This is the very first message of Jesus in his public ministry. "God is doing something new—Listen up!" It's hard for us who've heard these words so many times to hear them afresh. It's also hard to know what can shake us out of our lethargy, our dullness of spirit regarding God and the things of God.

Sometimes the unpredictable works of Mother Nature or other forces, i.e. massive floods, hurricanes, virus, etc. can awaken us, reminding us that God is God and we are only God's creatures. We need to hear the message of today's gospel as much as those to whom Jesus first proclaimed it.

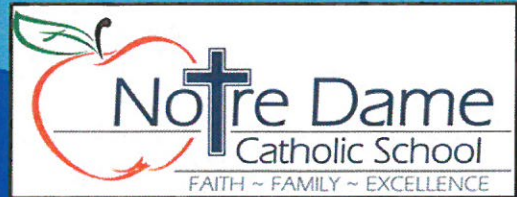
The tap is our interior lives. The drops of water are the peace, joy, love and happiness that are the fruits of prayer. The bucket is our hearts and souls.
