Second Sunday of Advent

Baruch 5:1-9; Philippians 1:4-6, 8-11; Luke 3:1-6

Before the advent of any major person to an area there is a lot of preparation. Thus, when the president visits a town for a talk, he prepares for the delivery, and the townspeople prepare for his coming. If it is a major presentation and the president is to stay awhile then even more elaborate preparations take place. A readiness comes into place.

St. Luke does this in his gospel narrative. Jesus Christ is coming on the scene. There needs to be preparation, there needs to be a readiness to receive him when he does arrive. John the Baptist is the front man, as we would say today. John gets the word out to the neighborhood: "Get ready! The advent of God's Messiah is at hand!" Throughout Christian history John has been called the forerunner of the Messiah.

The readiness John called for involved an inner preparation, a preparation in the heart. As we will see in more detail next week, that heart preparation meant being attentive to the neighbor's needs especially.

And so we enter the second week of Advent: John the Baptist calls us to be alert to those around us, to do good works. We need to look inward in prayerful reflection and outward to the neighbor. In doing this we make ready for the One Who comes.
