In continuation of the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC Par. 1329-1330) What is this Sacrament called? Paragraph 1330 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) states the Eucharist is also called "*The Holy and Divine Liturgy* because the Church's whole liturgy finds its center and most intense expression in the celebration of this sacrament; in the same sense we also call its celebration the *Sacred Mysteries*. We speak of the *Most Blessed Sacrament* because it is the Sacrament of sacraments. The Eucharistic species reserved in the tabernacle are designated this same name."

Stewardship is a commitment of mind and heart to the Lord; a way of life that needs constant renewal and transformation.
