**March 26, 2023**

**Fifth Sunday of Lent**

*Ezekiel 37:12-14; Romans 8:8-11; John 11:1-45*

The story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead is an astonishing story. The gospel of signs, as John has written it, builds and builds to this remarkable event. It is told to manifest the power of God at work in and through Jesus.

It is not that in the Jewish tradition such a remarkable event had never occurred before. It had. Elijah was a prophet of God who had raised a dead child to life. And was vilified because of it, just as Jesus would be vilified after raising Lazarus.

But the point of such stories—and of this one of John in particular—is to declare that the God of Israel is the author of all life, and has power over physical and moral death. Jesus did what he did to give glory so “that they may believe that you sent me.” And after each sign some did so believe; and some did not.

The works of power Jesus performed had that double effect—some saw God manifested in the powerful signs, some were hardened against Jesus.

Would it be any different today? Most likely not. But for us who do believe it is pure joy to hear Jesus' declaration:

“I am the resurrection and the life. . .”

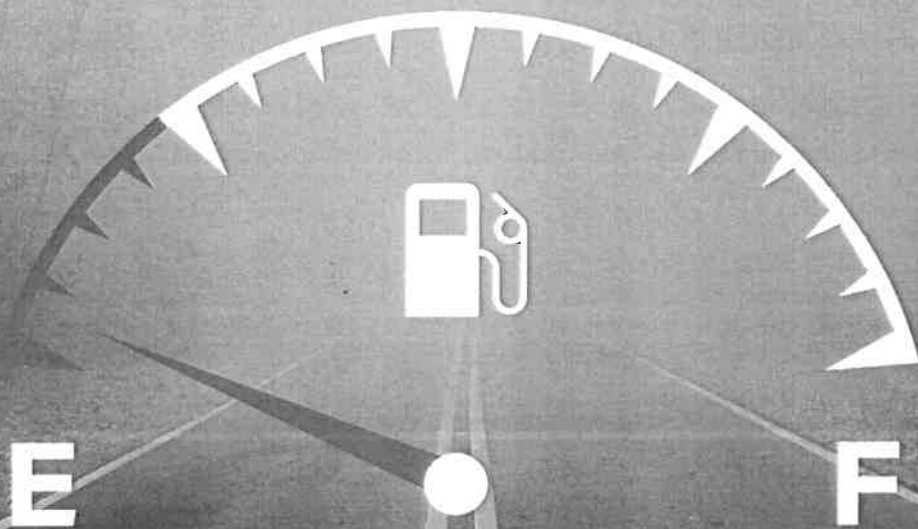
