Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord

Acts of the Apostles 10:34a, 37-43; Colossians 3:1-4; John 20:1-9

Who is trustworthy? What is trustworthy? In whom, can we place our hope? These are not small questions.

We wonder if humans can ever get along peaceably with one another. It is not too difficult to question whether there is hope for our human species to live together, to work together for justice and equality.

But even as we raise the questions, we once again celebrate the source of hope: "God has raised this Jesus who was crucified." And "everyone who believes in him will receive forgiveness of sins through his name."

In other words, God has not given up and does not give up on us humans. Easter is the annual feast of joy and life and possibility for us. Death does not hold dominion. Life does.

ArchdioceseOne Update Active fundraising for ArchdioceseOne will officially end on December 31, 2023.
