December 3, 2023

First Sunday of Advent

Isaiah 63:16b-17, 19b, 64:2-7; 1 Corinthians 1:3-9; Mark 13:33-37

"Would that you might meet us doing right, that we were mindful of you in our ways!"

The first Sunday of the Church's liturgical year is an echo of the last Sunday of the liturgical year: we await the Lord's coming. "Rend the heavens and come down. . ." the prophet cries!

This is a sharp reminder that the season of Advent is not just a hurried and harried few weeks of preparation to celebrate Jesus' birth. This season invites us to look forward to the end, as well as to look back toward the beginning.

All this really translates into the oft overlooked reality that God's saving power acts upon us in the present. God meets us, as the prophets says, right now. And the prophet goes on to say that hopefully that meeting will find us "doing right."

Sometimes in the hustle and bustle to get everything in place for the celebration on Dec. 25th, we miss the presence of God meeting us in lots of subtle ways on Dec. 3, Dec. 8th, Dec. 15th—indeed each day of the Advent season. We need to be alert to God's presence, right now, as we write cards, shop, bake, visit friends, go caroling, and do the countless things we do the next several weeks. If we are alert, awake, attentive, we will experience God rending the heavens to come down to us each day, not just on Christmas morning.

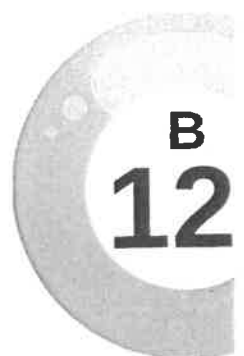
