"From the first days of the Church's celebration of the Eucharist, Holy Communion consisted of the reception of both species in fulfillment of the Lord's command to 'take and eat...take and drink.'" (General Instruction of the Roman Missal 17)

I am excited to announce that starting Saturday June 8th and Sunday June 9th, Notre Dame Parish will be once again offering the Precious Blood of Jesus at each weekend liturgy!

This practice was suppressed during the COVID-19 Pandemic and continued to be discontinued until now.

Although Jesus is truly present; Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the host alone, the restoration of this practice enables the faithful to "experience a fuller sign of the Eucharistic Banquet" (Council of Trent).

Partaking of the chalice is not a requirement for full union with Jesus at Mass, but it's availability increases the richness of our feast together.

I hope that this opportunity will enhance your prayer life and help you to grow as a disciple of Jesus, the Bread of Life! Detailed instructions and further teaching will be forthcoming.
