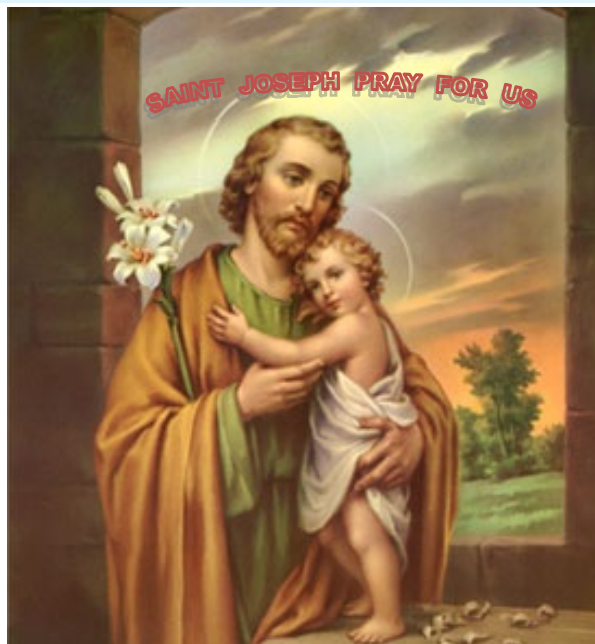

The mission of St. Joseph's Church is to be a welcoming, caring, Christ-centered Catholic community. We desire to experience and share God's unconditional love. Inspired by the example of Jesus, we strive to lead all people to wholeness and fullness of life.

The Sacrament of Marriage is celebrated after a period of preparation of no less than six months. Registered parishioners who wish to marry at St. Joseph's are invited to contact one of the priests during regular weekday office hours before making any other arrangements.

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated, except during Lent, on the first and third Sundays of the month at 1:30pm. Please call the Parish Office to schedule an appointment with one of the priests.

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is available at any time to any Catholic over the age of reason who is seriously ill, preparing for surgery or suffering the effects of age. The priests of the parish regularly celebrate the Eucharist and administer the sacrament of the sick at the area nursing homes; lay ministers lead services and bring communion to the residents every Sunday.

From the Desk of Fr. Lagiovane

Over the last several months, a number of parishioners have approached me regarding what appears to be at times excessive talking by some before and after Mass. I would respectfully ask that all of us be conscious of not using the main body of the Church as an area for ongoing socializing. Many people enjoy arriving early for Mass so they can spend some quiet time in prayer before Mass begins, as well as those who stay for some time after Mass to say some prayers. Ongoing conversations in the pews prevent our neighbors from enjoying this special time before our Lord, present in the Most Blessed Sacrament. Our beautiful Narthex is an ideal area for all of us to catch up and greet each other. I certainly encourage fellowship and socializing while maintaining a respectful silence in the main body of the Church, which gives us all the opportunity to speak to God in the silence of our hearts.

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This upcoming week we remember the Supreme Court Decision Roe Vs. Wade which legalized abortion in the United States. Our unborn brothers and sisters are in need of our prayers. They have no voice and we as a people of faith must be the voice of the unborn. This week as well, we remember Dr. Martin Luther King Jr, the civil rights leader who preached respect and dignity for all God's children. His prayer was that people would be judged by the content of their character and not the color of their skin.

We pray in a very special way for a greater respect for all human life- from conception through natural death.

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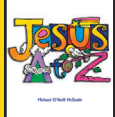



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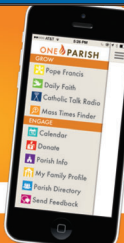


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
