CARNIVAL

From the Desk of Father Lagiovane
The Solemn Feast of the Assumption- August 15th

This significant feast day recalls the spiritual and physical departure of the mother of Jesus Christ from the earth, when both her soul and her body were taken into the presence of God.

Venerable Pope Pius XII confirmed this belief about the Virgin Mary as the perennial teaching of the Church when he defined it formally as a dogma of Catholic faith in 1950, invoking papal infallibility to proclaim, “that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory.”

His Apostolic Constitution “Munificentissimus Deus” (Most Bountiful God), which defined the dogma, contained the Pontiff’s accounts of many longstanding traditions by which the Church has celebrated the Assumption throughout its history.

The constitution also cited testimonies from the early Church fathers on the subject, and described the history of theological reflection on many Biblical passages which are seen as indicating that Mary was assumed into heaven following her death.

Although the bodily assumption of Mary is not explicitly recorded in Scripture, Catholic tradition identifies her with the “woman clothed with the sun” who is described in the 12th chapter of the Book of Revelation.

The passage calls that woman's appearance “a great sign” which “appeared in heaven,” indicating that she is the mother of the Jewish Messiah and has “the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.” Accordingly, Catholic iconography of the Western tradition often depicts the Virgin Mary's assumption into heaven in this manner

“It was fitting,” St. John of Damascus wrote in a sermon on the Assumption, “that she, who had kept her virginity intact in childbirth, should keep her own body free from all corruption even after death,” and “that she, who had carried the creator as a child at her breast, should dwell in the divine tabernacles.”

DRESS IN CHURCH

In the book of Ecclesiastes it is written in the third chapter, "There is an appropriate time for everything, and a time for every affair under the heavens. A time to be silent and a time to speak". In other words everything has an appropriate place.

I would add a time to dress up and a time to dress down. We come now into the summer season, the season of flip-flops, shorts, tank tops and anything else that lets in the sun and cool breezes. The season also brings the dilemma of what is appropriate dress.

Are shorts appropriate at a wedding reception, or job interview? Is wearing a suit and tie to the beach called for? Do we wear a dress or pants with shoes to bed and pajamas to the supermarket?

I ask you to consider what you wear to worship your Creator. Is He important enough to dress up for? Oh, yes it is true that God loves us just the way we are. Saint Paul writes that because of his relationship with Jesus, he is free to do anything, but qualifies that freedom, with his obligation not to offend or bring harm to others. The question is, how much we respect the love our Creator has for us: and are we willing to witness to others that respect, by our dress and behavior? There is a time for everything.

A Brief History of St. Joseph's Parish

In 1845 St. Joseph's Parish was established by Archbishop John Hughes to serve a growing Catholic population in Northern Westchester. This growth was spurred by increasing Catholic emigration to America, primarily from Ireland and the extension of railroad tracks from New York City.

The first church was built in 1849 near the railroad on Rte. 22. The Parish and its missions served a growing flock. From 1853-1867, 197 marriages were recorded in the Parish, of which 185 had Irish surnames. The first church was destroyed in 1893 by a fire ignited by sparks from a passing locomotive.

St. Joseph's Church was too small and remote to serve all its parishioners even after new parishes were portioned off from the original boundaries. In response, two chapels were built. In 1916 St. John's on Rte. 116 in North Salem was opened. Twenty years prior in 1886, St. Michael's Chapel was opened in Golden's Bridge along the railroad and Bedford Rd. The Christian Brothers at the Lincoln Hall school for boys, opened the St. John the Baptist de la Salle Chapel in 1965.

The day finally arrived in June of 2014. On a glorious Sunday the New St. Joseph's Catholic Church now located at 95 Plum Brook Road was dedicated in a Mass and ceremony presided over by both Cardinal Dolan and his predecessor Cardinal Egan. Relics deposited in the altar are: St. Frances Xavier Cabrini, St. Agnes, St. Gregory the Great, St. Mary Magdalene De Pazzi, St. Maria Goretti, St. Teresa of Avila. This breathtaking house of worship will with God's help withstand both fire and flood and remain a testament to the loyal Parishioners, Nuns and Priests who have served this Parish for the last 175 plus years.
