



Los seres humanos tenemos la inclinación natural a instalarnos cuando hemos alcanzado un cierto nivel de satisfacción. No podemos evadir nuestras responsabilidades. La construcción del Reino de Dios pide nuestro compromiso aquí y ahora, sin escapismos, sin falsos misticismos.
