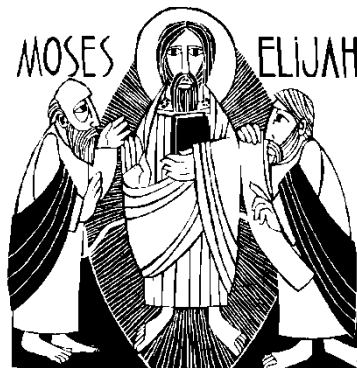

Los seres humanos tenemos la inclinación natural a instalarnos cuando hemos alcanzado un cierto nivel de satisfacción. Así perdemos el impulso para emprender nuevas acciones, evitamos realizar gestos concretos de solidaridad que nos causen una cierta incomodidad. Esta misma tentación de instalamiento la vivimos en la experiencia religiosa, como le sucedió a Pedro.
