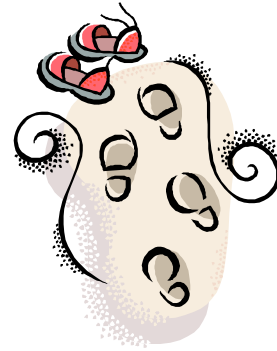
Religious Education classes for the 2018-2019 year begin September 16th. Please note that all students must be registered or re-registered before classes begin.

1. **Negarse a sí mismo:** olvidarse de sí mismo. Es decirle a ese yo que todos llevamos dentro y que nos inclina a ser egocéntricos, autónomos y autosuficientes, que no queremos seguir nuestros propios planes, ni nuestros propios intereses, sino depender en todo de Dios y de hacer y sufrir todo cuanto Él tenga para nosotros. Ni que decir tengo que el mayor obstáculo para encontrar y seguir a Dios en nuestra vida no son los demás, ni las circunstancias de la vida... el mayor obstáculo somos nosotros mismos. Hay que redirigir nuestro yo a Cristo y dejar que sea Dios quien lo oriente. Es nuestro yo quien nos ata y nos hace ver cosas que no hay y sentir cosas que no son reales. La fe nos ayuda a la reeducación del yo.

2. **Tomar la cruz:** no se refiere a los problemas de la vida que nos aparecen por doquier... Es asumir la carga del sacrificio. El seguidor de Jesús debe alistarse en la fila de los condenados a muerte a los deseos de sí mismos. La cruz es la carga que tomamos voluntariamente por servir al Evangelio del Señor. La cruz la hemos de tomar y seguir con ella a Cristo. No debemos hacernos la cruz nosotros mismos, sino arrimar el hombro a la que Dios ha preparado, sin temer su peso, sin ir cargados de miedos.

3. **Seguirle:** es ir al ritmo de Dios en nuestra vida.
