❖ A Reflection ❖

"THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS AT HAND"

"In today's Gospel we hear Jesus' first words in Mark: 'This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe the gospel.' These reveal the heart of Jesus' message and ministry in a number of ways. First, when [Jesus] says, 'This is the time of fulfillment,' he uses the Greek term **kairos** – 'sacred time,' not **chronos**, chronological time. Jesus came to announce that Israel's 'sacred time' was fulfilled in and through the present reality of the kingdom of God. Second, 'the kingdom of God' is the centerpiece of Jesus' preaching in his public ministry. In Mark's account, when Jesus speaks of the kingdom of God, he uses metaphors of parables that would resonate with peasants in the rural villages of Galilee. Third, repentance (in Greek, *metanoia*; literally, a 'change of mind') is required to understand, and enter into, the kingdom of God. Jesus teaches that one cannot 'believe' in the Gospel ('good news') of the kingdom of God without changing the way one thinks. Repentance requires conversion, turning back to God and turning away from that which distracts from God."



caerá muy presto del primer estado.


¿Adónde, Pablo, de soberbia armado

Santos Timoteo y Tito



Timoteo Et.: del griego, "el que honra a Dios". Nació en Listra. Hijo de padre pagano y de madre judeocristiana (Cf. Hechos 16, 1-4; 19, 22; 20,4). Aparece en el Nuevo Testamento como el discípulo mas cercano a Pablo quien le acompañó en varios viajes. Pablo le nombró obispo de Efeso y le dirigió dos epístolas para orientarlo en la dirección de sus comunidades. (Al partir yo para Macedonia te rogué que permanecieras en Efeso para que mandarás a algunos que no enseñasen doctrinas extrañas. -1 Tim 1,3)

Tito San Tito aparece en las cartas de San Pablo de quien era discípulo adherido (2 Cor 2,13; 7,6-15; 8,23). Acompañó a Pablo al Concilio de Jerusalén ("subí nuevamente a Jerusalén con Bernabé, llevando conmigo también a Tito". -Gal 2,1). Allí se discutió la circuncisión (Tito no era circuncidado. Cf. Gal 2,3). Evangelizó a Dalmacia (Yugoslavia) (Cf. 2 Timoteo 4,10). Pablo lo consagró obispo de la isla de Creta. ("El motivo de haberte dejado en Creta, fue para que acabaras de organizar lo que faltaba y establecieras presbíteros en cada ciudad, como yo te ordené. -Tito 1,5). Según la tradición murió en Creta de edad avanzada.
