


Congratulations and Welcome!

“THEY DID NOT YET UNDERSTAND ...”

“On this joyous Easter Sunday, we celebrate what God has done for Jesus and, through him, for us: God has ‘raised’ all that has been ‘put to death.’ And yet, John indicates, the full reality of what God accomplished in Christ and in those raised with him dawned only slowly on Jesus’ followers. Even the disciples who saw an empty tomb and burial cloths ‘did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.’ But the evangelist also presents a vivid example of how understanding often begins: in believing. At this point, the ‘other disciple’ does not see Jesus, but suggestions of what God had done in him. And yet, the disciple ‘believed.’” – *At Home with the Word*
