Chapter Seven—Unburden Yourself: Money & Things

To a certain point, money and things do simplify our lives, but we are beyond that point where they add complexity to our lives. We need to be aware of the ways they can affect us and complicate our lives. A great line from the movie *Wall Street*, "The thing about money is that it makes you do things you don't want to do." For thousands of years people have been doing things they would rather not do in order to work their way up to doing what they really want to do. It's a way of life and contributes to helping us create clarity about who we are, what we are here for, and what is really important to us.

Money has a unique way of clouding our judgement. The money itself is just dirty paper, and what it represents to most people is not just more stuff but also more opportunities. Lack of opportunity devastates not the body but also the spirit. The great appeal of money is that it can buy opportunities, in the form of education, travel, or more leisure time. It is usually the imagined opportunity that induces us, not the money.

After the money comes the things—the stuff we buy because we just have to have it, because everyone else has one, we buy stuff because we are having a bad day, or we feel like rewarding ourselves. The thing about possessions is that they rent space in our minds. Everything we have requires mind space, and mind space is limited, so the more you crowd it, the more confusing things (life) become. **Question to consider:** *How have we allowed money or material possessions to impact our lives? Have we made them more important than GOD?*

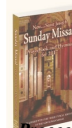
