Chapter 4: The Meaning of Work

Most people don't like their work and don't like to work. Given a choice, many people would sit around idle and waste their lives completely. That's a sweeping statement, but if you think it isn't true, conduct a brief survey on how many people you know who already spend the time they have doing whatever they wish with it.

We encourage children to work hard because whether we are able to articulate it or not, we know that working hard and happiness are linked. I was giving a presentation to a corporate group recently, and during one of the question-answer sessions, one of the attendees offhandedly commented that if Adam and Eve hadn't eaten the apple, we would never have had to work. That's a common misconception. But in fact, as I point out to him in the Old Testament passage to which he was referring, even before the apple was eaten, God has placed Adam in the garden to "tend and till the soil".

Work is not a punishment. What is the meaning of work? Why do we work? Some would argue, "Because we have to!" and others would say, "To make money." Both would be wrong. In truth, you don't have to do anything. Nobody can make you do anything. At some level, we choose to work. And contrary to the overwhelming popular view that we work to make money, making money is actually the secondary purpose for work.

The primary meaning, purpose, and value of work is that when we work hard and well, when we pay attention to the details of our work, we develop character and virtue. By working hard, I develop the virtues of perseverance and fortitude; by paying attention to the details of my work, I develop patience and responsibility; and by working well, I develop diligence.

When we work, we gain the opportunity to partner with God. As Mother Teresa pointed out time and again, in a very real and practical sense we are God's hands and feet. "For we are God's fellow workers.." (1 Cor 3:9). This is partly why so many of us yearn for meaningful work. We yearn to participate in what God's doing in the world.

When work is approached in the right way and with the right frame of mind, it helps us to become more perfectly ourselves. Who you are is definitely more important than what you do or what your have. Life everything else in life, the value of work is in the way it helps us to become the best-versions-of-ourselves. Work is at the essence of our quest for character. It is important that we remain active. Work is a source of a healthy mind and body. Happiness is founded in doing things that we can take pride in doing well and hence can enjoy doing.
