I look forward to sharing the rest of our year with you.



Dear Holy Spirit Parish:

"Jesus looked up to heaven and groaned: *Ephphatha...* be opened!" (Mark 7:34)

Oh, don't we all know that groan... born of the longing for someone to become open. And if you haven't opened the eyes of the

blind or the ears of the deaf, it surely is in part because the world is in far greater need of the opening of people's minds and hearts. Fr. Mallon's recipe for opening minds and hearts in his book <u>Divine Renovation</u> is not unlike Jesus' in today's Gospel: Jesus took the man off by himself, touched him where he was broken and prayed *Ephphatha*. I quote Fr. Mallon at length:

Fifty years ago, if you behaved properly and believed correctly, you could belong. How things have changed. We now live in a hyper-individualistic post-modern culture. Gen Xers... will not behave in any particular manner just because it is what they are supposed to do. Most people today will behave in a particular way only if it lines up with their personal beliefs. Appeals to authority or tradition hold no water...

Belief systems are of little value. There is no sense of obligation to anything beyond the individual and his or her own personal - and private - beliefs. Most people today are not compelled by a quest for truth and are largely uninterested in doctrine or any proposal that presents a systematic, comprehensive worldview.... While this may be distressing to many of us, we must recognize that this is our new reality, and this is the character of a generation to which we are called to bring the Gospel. Most people join, stay and leave churches not because of belief, but because of a sense of belonging, because of community. The old order of behaving-believing-belonging has been reversed. Beliefs are changed not by preaching and teaching, but by building trust through relationships, through caring, through belonging. (pg. 139)

In my own words, if we want to open the minds and hearts of young people today we need to spend one-on-one time with them (Jesus took the man off by himself), listen to them then listen to them more until they feel safe enough to let you touch their broken places (Jesus touched his ears and tongue), then with a full heart invite them to be open (and Jesus cried *Ephphatha*).

In light of this Gospel, simple things have taken on tremendous importance for me. Our first Student Supper and evening Mass this week are truly Jesus' invitation to come away and be alone with him. The small group bible studies beginning this week are an opportunity for young people to talk and talk until their heart comes to light. Our parish discussion about whether or not to multiply the number of these small groups by adding FOCUS missionaries to our staff has me crying *Ephphatha* in my prayer.

To address questions and concerns people may have about FOCUS, we have invited Fr. Billy Dodge, pastor of the Newman Center in La Crosse, to come up with some of his students and speak at all of the Masses Oct 16 &17 about their experience with FOCUS missionaries.

This Gospel also moves me to think about the Alpha program as Fr. Mallon does. He writes: "Alpha is not just one of many programs we use, but that it is foundational to our identity as a missional and evangelizing Church." (pg. 143). "It embraces the belong-believe-behave approach to evangelization. It is perfectly suited for the post-modern mindset." (pg. 142)

Our next round of Alpha is beginning in just two weeks. Tuesday evening Sept. 21 at 6:00pm or Friday morning Sept. 24 at 9:00am, we will step aside to be with Jesus, talk and talk until our hearts become clear, then pray over one another: *Ephphatha!* I am praying every member of Holy Spirit Parish will, in time, experience this healing.
