Fr Billy Dodge, the pastor at the Roncalli Newman Center in La Crosse, will be joining us at the weekend Masses Oct 16/17. He will be sharing information about the national organization FOCUS and how it has impacted his campus, students & parish. There will be the opportunity for a Q&A session after each of the Masses for all to participate in.

We are looking forward to the potential of having FOCUS missionaries on our own campus in the future and hope you will share in this informational presentation and get answers to any questions you may have!

Dear Holy Spirit Parish:

"Who can be saved?...For human beings it is impossible, but not for God."

(Mark 10:26-27)

Pelagianism. Everyone who has been reading Fr Mallon's book <u>Divine Renovation</u> is now familiar with this word. After the persecutions stopped in 313 AD, people started going out into the desert as a way to respond to Jesus' invitation to leave everything and follow him. People being people, even out there, competition set in over who was doing it best. A subtle heresy crept in: If I do enough, I will earn my way to heaven. Jesus tells his disciples straight out: It is impossible for you to save yourself. Only God can.

Next weekend Fr. Billy Dodge, the pastor of the Newman Center in La Crosse, will be preaching at all our Masses. We have asked him to come with some of his students to share their experience of FOCUS (the Fellowship of Catholic University Students.). At the August meeting of the Pastoral Council our Campus Ministry Committee received approval to study the feasibility of adding a team of FOCUS missionaries to our Point Catholic Ministries. The determination of whether it is feasible or not depends on three things: Does their spirituality align with Holy Spirit Parish's? How will we fund this ministry? Do we have the other resources needed to support this ministry?

I do not include in our list of concerns the organization's effectiveness. FOCUS' effectiveness is well established. It has spread from one campus in 1998 to 187 campus in 2020 and from a handful of college students to nearly 800 student Missionaries. Some do, however, question the more traditional spirituality they practice. Please come next Sunday to hear Fr. Dodge address this question and to meet some of the students who are involved. As you listen keep in mind: Pelagianism. In a world where students are under tremendous pressures to perform and to succeed, the old traditional religion of grace is very appealing. We don't have to do good things to earn God's love. It's because we are already loved by God that we are free to do our very best.

We will know much more about the second question—funding—by Tuesday of this week. Fr. Billy Dodge will be presenting a proposal to the executive committee of St. Ambrose Financial Services that they fund FOCUS missionaries for all four parishes with Campus Ministries in the Diocese. St. Ambrose is an independent financial corporation created by the Diocese of La Crosse to provide banking services to the parishes of the Diocese. Perhaps you remember that St. Ambrose contributed \$3 million to the campaign to repair the Cathedral. The executive committee will decide if our request meets their criterion of using investment income on the savings deposited by parishes only on projects that benefit all parishes. If the executive committee decides it does meet their criterion, our proposal will go to the full St. Ambrose Board meeting later in October. We of course feel that since we are ministering to young adults from all over the diocese and who return to locations all over the Diocese, we meet their criterion. We will know soon if they agree.

That leaves the third concern, are we ready to have 300 students involved, like they have in La Crosse? Space is the first issue that comes to my mind. The rectory would be a very important resource in terms of housing bible studies and other small group activities. FOCUS leadership tells us that their missionaries often live in abandoned rectories in the parishes they serve. We are having the electrical service and plumbing evaluated. The renovation of Kostka Hall also takes on new importance.

As excited as I am by all that seems to be coming together here, I try to remember: It is impossible for us to make this happen. God, it's up to you.
