Dear Holy Spirit Parish:

"The blind man threw aside his cloak, sprang up, and came to Jesus." (Mark 10:50)

We all cloak our hearts in layers of protection. Unfortunately, they separate us from love as well as hurt. They leave us in the dark, blind. Bartimaeus' friends told him "Jesus is calling. Do not to be afraid." Throw-

ing off his cloak, he stepped into the light.

The core message I hear from Fr. Mallon's book <u>Divine Renovation</u> and from Ron Huntley, our keynote speaker for Saturday's Deanery Convocation, is: "Jesus is calling. Do not be afraid."

I have cloaked my heart beneath many layers of protection: "I don't trust those other parishes in the deanery. I'm looking out for just Holy Spirit parish." "These ideas of Fr. Mallon and Mr. Huntley sound Protestant to me. They can't be good." "I've been to too many workshops to count. What's another workshop going to do." "Church leadership is never going to change. Why try." These attitudes keep me from getting hurt, but they also keep me from growth and new life.

There is a lot I am looking forward to at Saturday's Convocation at the Holiday Inn. In one workshop, our very own Sherry Boyce and Joann Chase will be sharing what we have learned so far from the Stephen Ministry Program. Another workshop I plan to catch will be led by Joyana (Jacoby) Dvorak. A native of Stevens Point, Joyana is now an adjunct faculty member in the Peace, Justice and Conflict Studies Program at DePaul University. Her morning breakout session will lay out core Catholic teachings on Social Justice. The afternoon session will be a chance for people from area parishes to come together and coordinate their efforts in the deanery. There are workshops in liturgical music, hospitality, adult formation, Elizabeth Ministries and youth ministry as well. You may register at the door. Registration opens at 8:00am. Mass begins at 8:30am. The Keynote is at 9:30am. The day is free with a free will offering for lunch. "Bartimaeus, Jesus is calling. Do not be afraid."

Next weekend, being the closest weekend to All Saints and All Souls Days, we will remember the loved ones we lost this past year. At each of the Masses, during the time of the Intercessions, we pray for each of them by name. We will again have a table of remembrance in the alcove where the vigil light stand normally is. All are invited to place there, their pictures of loved ones they have lost, whether this year or in other years, whether parish member or not. It is helpful to have their name on the front of the picture and your name and phone number on the back. The pictures can remain there until the weekend of November 20 & 21 when you can take them home again. With your name and phone number on the back we will be able to remind you if you forget. We will be remembering many great souls who more than once "threw off their cloak and came to Jesus."

With Confirmation coming November 7<sup>th</sup>, I have had the pleasure this past week of starting to interview our sixteen candidates. I must confess that the young person is not the only one who sits down to the table with their heart cloaked. From some years of experience, I come to the table fearing I will meet an adolescent angry about being forced to do something they don't believe in. And they, I can well imagine, come fearing judgement and rejection. So far, in all of the interviews, after just a few minutes of conversation, the cloaks have been cast aside and the light and love of Christ fills the room. I will proudly ask Bishop Callahan November 7<sup>th</sup> to Confirm, seal and strengthen the lovely Spirit growing in their hearts.


- Toddler and baby clothing winter onesies
