

Dear Holy Spirit Parish:

“Go and do...”

(Luke 10:37)



To the thinker, the young scholar of the law, who wanted to know how to get to heaven, Jesus said there is something he must “do.” My mentor in the priesthood, Fr. Dick Mauthe, the Chaplain at UW Green Bay where I first attended college, said this once, but it has stayed with me ever since: “Most people try to think their way into a new way of doing. But it is more often the case that doing something new changes our way of thinking.” Jesus said, “go and learn the meaning of mercy.”

The Divine Renovation movement in the Church teaches the same truth in slightly different words. They say, “in the Catholic Church it has always been: You must believe what we believe and behave the way we behave before you are allowed to belong.” According to Fr. Mallon, growing Churches today approach it like Fr. Mauthe... and Jesus: “Come and belong, and you will grow to believe and in time behave.”

Day by day we are growing more deeply involved in the Divine Renovation process. This past Wednesday our Divine Renovation coach zoomed in from the East Coast to meet with our Alpha Leadership and take Alpha to the next level. This coming Tuesday we meet with her again to unpack a leadership strengths and weakness test we took as a staff. Later in the month we will meet with her again to begin mining the meaning of our ME25 survey.

Next Sunday, Deacon Bill, Julie Meadows and I will be joining Fr. Ed Shuttleworth and Julie Studinski from St. Brons on a trip to Dallas, Texas for the annual Divine Renovation Conference. I don't know how many are involved but the conference is sold out with people coming from all over the United States. The five of us met last Thursday to decide who would go to which workshop so we would bring home as much as possible. Including keynotes from Fr. James Mallon, who wrote the book on Divine Renovation, there are breakouts on all aspects of parish growth. The conference runs from Monday through Wednesday noon.

In my place next Sunday Fr. Robert Hundt will preside at the 8:00am and 10:30am Masses. Fr. Hundt has been the head of the Marriage Tribunal in our Diocese for many years. He has agreed to give a talk between the Masses (9:15am) on why the Church grants annulments and what the process involves. I have worked with Fr. Hundt on many annulments and find him to be a wise and compassionate man. That he might make it back to La Crosse at a reasonable hour, Fr. Eric Mashak, the assistant at St. Brons, has most kindly agreed to preside at the 6:00pm... after covering all the Masses at St. Bron's in Fr. Ed's absence.

Much else is getting done this week as well. At the time of this writing we were waiting to hear from the person we interviewed for the Director of Faith Formation position Julie Meadows is leaving. The staff, the Faith Formation Committee, and members of the Parish Council who took part in the three sessions of interviews were all enthusiastic unanimous in feeling she was the right person for us and we should offer her the job. Hopefully by the time you read this we will have announced her acceptance!

This Monday a group of 15 or so people are gathering to wash windows and do deep cleaning at the rectory. Then we will start moving in furniture in preparation for the arrive of our FOCUS team around the 27<sup>th</sup>. At the time of this writing Deacon Rick was still tolerating his chemo and radiation well. And Fr. Todd was not yet answering phones or email.

If you don't feel like your faith is growing, go, do and learn with us.


### Caring for the Sick:
