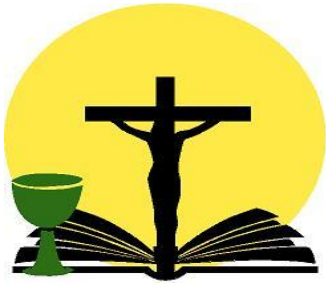

Understand DVT And PE Symptoms - No Time to Wait

DVT (deep vein thrombosis): throbbing or cramping pain in 1 leg (rarely both legs), usually in the calf or thigh, swelling in 1 leg (rarely both legs), warm skin around the painful area, red or darkened skin around the painful area.

PE Pulmonary Embolism: swollen veins that are hard or sore when you touch them, Sudden shortness of breath, Chest pain or discomfort that worsens when you take a deep breath or when you cough, feeling lightheaded or dizzy, or fainting, Rapid pulse, Rapid breathing, Coughing up blood.

Stewardship Reflection on Readings for Sun., 7 Feb., the Authority and Power of Jesus.

Our readings today remind us that Christ came to serve. Jesus' entire life was focused on others. He came to fulfill His Father's mission — the salvation of mankind. He labored for this mission by becoming the humblest of servants.

 - In Tyler: Dr. Lloyd and Dr. Lawrence at the Exceptional Emergency Center, 2222 ESE Loop 323, Tyler, TX (903-707-8140). Note – Dr. Lawrence is really on top of this issue! This is close to the Troop Hwy/Loop 323 intersection. This is an Emergency Center whose treatment rates are higher than clinics. The initial visit may be free. Personal insurance usually covers costs. Medicare and Medicaid are not accepted. Cash price for full visit, \$210. Note – speak with Dr. Lloyd or Dr. Lawrence.
 - Dr. Paul Guttuso, Family Medicine at Texas Health family and Sports Care, 604 South 3rd Street, Suite A, Mabank, TX 75147. Call for appointment (903-887-1073) Cash cost for visit is \$110 plus \$30 medicine. Identify yourself as referred by Father Paul Key.

For strengthening immune system. A doctor recommended set of supplements: 3,000 I.U. of vitamin D-3, both morning and evening; 50 mg of Zinc, morning and evening, and 1,000 mg vitamin C per day.

For hydroxychloroquine as a preventative (prophylactic), go to the following website, speakwithanmd.com. You can also connect with this through the website for Americasfrontlinedoctors.com.

Free COVID test if you have insurance or Medicare. “Care First Medical Center” at 13027 SH 155 South, 903-839-1000. Test takes 24 to 48 hours to be reported. No appointments, walk-in. If you get your test here and then go to the Exceptional EMR Center, you will save \$60.
