Stewardship Bulletin Reflection

Stewardship reflection for Sunday, August 1, 2021 See nd reading, Eph 4:17,20-24

To be prepared for the Eucharist we must pay attention to the stewardship of our minds. The reading from Ephesians says it well: “Brothers and sisters: I declare and testify in the Lord that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds... rather be renewed in the spirit of your minds.” This is just like the guidance from Romans 12:1-2: “Do not be conformed to this age but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and pleasing and perfect.”

How can we do this? I propose that this means we must, at a minimum, present ourselves to God at Mass every single week, first to give Him adoration and praise, second, to have our minds enlightened by Scripture and preaching, thirdly, entering prayer for ourselves and the whole world, and then finally by being united with Jesus as we celebrate the most Holy Eucharist and receive the Body and Blood of our Lord in Communion. Then, further, we have one additional Mass during the week to accomplish all of this. Then further, we have Thursday evening for Adoration and prayer. Can you make it as a Christian in the world without these? What is your strategy?
