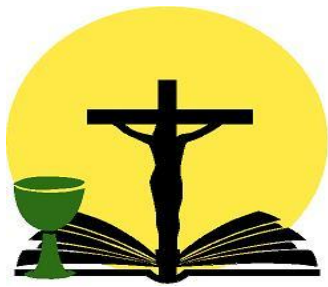

From your Parish Nurse:

Irritable bowel syndrome (IBS) is a common disorder that affects the large intestine. Signs and symptoms include cramping, abdominal pain, bloating, gas, and diarrhea or constipation, or both. IBS is a chronic condition that you'll need to manage long term.

Only a small number of people with IBS have severe signs and symptoms. Some people can control their symptoms by managing diet, lifestyle and stress. More-severe symptoms can be treated with medication and counseling.

IBS doesn't cause changes in bowel tissue or increase your risk of colorectal cancer.

Concern for the Mass: Respect and Reverence

- 1. Loud Talking** is not appropriate. **Please**, greet your neighbor, say hello to a friend, welcome a newcomer, but always with respect for where you are.
- We **turn off cell phones and pagers** so that the sacred nature of the liturgy is not disturbed.
- Dress well in modestly** as we gather to celebrate the Eucharist, our secret meal a sacrifice. We are gathered to meet the Lord in the liturgy and each other, and dress shows respect for that truth.
- Chewing gum or eating** is inappropriate in the church. Children's snacks should be a simple as possible, and parents need to clean up any spills.
- We are **consciously reverted** toward the presence of the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle. We genuflect to Christ in the Blessed Sacrament when we enter and exit the church. We bow to the altar as a sign of Christ when we pass in front of it.
- Listen respectfully** to the word of God as it is proclaimed. Christ is truly present in the word. **Crying children** can be taken to the community room or outside until they are Carme call me enough to return.
- Participate consciously in actively** with your brothers and sisters gathered for the Eucharistic Liturgy. Christ is truly present in the community gathered. Sing, pray, meditate in silence, give yourself fully.
- Pray and respond** during the Eucharistic prayer. The real presence of Christ is in the bread and wine that become His Body and Blood on the altar by the power of the Holy Spirit, the action of the priest and the prayer of the people.
- Sing with the full hearts and minds and voices** during the entire liturgy. Each hymn, refrain and response is a prayer of the community.
- Respect the space around you.** Put the missalette and hymnal back in the rack, take your bulletin with you, check for any papers or trash. Make your place clean and welcoming for those who will come to the next liturgy.
- Out of **respect** for the sacred liturgy, we come early enough to be comfortably seated and in a prayerful disposition before the Mass begins. We do not leave before the priest, deacon, and servers have processed out.

Stewardship Bulletin Reflection March 27, 2022 — Fourth Sunday of Lent

EX: 3:1-8A, 13.15; PS 103: 1-4, 6-8, 11; 1 COR 10:1-6, 10-12, LK 13:1-9

We are all familiar with this amazing story — the bratty younger son who has the audacity to ask his dad for his inheritance early, only to squander it sinfully away. It makes us bristle instinctively at his nerve when we read it. But isn't that exactly what we do when we selfishly turn away from God (in big or small ways) in our own lives? We squander away the inheritance of grace He has given us.

In desperation from the mess he had made of his life, the son finally “comes to his senses” — awakening to the truth that he is a beloved son of a loving and merciful father — and decides to return home. His contrition is faltering and imperfect and seems motivated in large part by his growling stomach. But it is enough for the loving father.

In fact, as soon as the father catches sight of his son he is “filled with compassion for him” and immediately sets about preparing a feast and fine clothes for this son. What an extravagance of love! What a beautiful picture Jesus gives us of our Father's love and mercy. Oh, how this should fill us with gratitude for such a Father!

And how it should inspire us — with just the tiniest bit of spiritual “spring cleaning” we can be sure we Will be swept up in our Father's loving embrace and find ourselves feasting in His presence. That is what lent is all about.
