Eucharistic Revival:

Currently our team has progressed to the state of Accompaniment. We have a strong core group. Bishop Cozzens wants us to converge our Missionary Disciple team with the Eucharist Revival. There are 3 phases in the ER. Phase 1 at the diocesan parish level was explained as personal encounters with Christ. Personal prayer, adoration, bring blessed sacraments to the nursing homes etc.

The 2nd phase is parish level with Mercy hours, music, kneeling before Monstrance, and healing for family and marriage. Form Eucharistic Missionary teams from Nov. 2022 to Jan. 2023.

The 3rd phase will include a National Conference in Indianapolis in the summer of 2024. The group is encouraged to sign up for the conference and to invite other parishioners to join us. We came up with names of parishioners we thought may be interested in the conference and will contact them. 80,000 people are expected to attend the conference. Our diocese has been given 125 tickets Registration is \$200, and transportation and lodging will be additional expenses. Response is needed by Jan 31, 2023.

The Missionary Disciple team has agreed to become the core group for the Eucharistic Revival. We will open up the group to other parishioners to join. At our next meeting in March we will come up with ideas on what activities we want to form. We will read the book "Going Forth as a Missionary Disciple", by Deacon Mark Krejci, view videos from Bishop Cozzens by March 15 meeting. If we organize small discussion groups we will schedule 6 weeks after Easter and before Memorial Day.

Adoration

Adoration is held at OLP on Friday mornings after mass.

STC will start to have adoration after the mass on the 3rd Sunday of the month. The Eucharistic ministers will help with this. The first one being Jan. 15. Dee contacted Jackie Duff, Wanda Baumgartner, and Kevin and Dee to help. They will have a training session on Jan. 11 after the Release time class.

Corpus Christi procession at STC will be after mass and proceed around the outside of the church.

During Lent after Stations of the Cross we will have time for personal adoration. Every other Friday will be a scripture Stations and then adoration.

OLP wants to engage the parents of the Faith Formation students on Wednesday nights with adoration, this will start the first of Lent after Ash Wednesday. John will organize with the Eucharistic team, a presentation for the parents.

The Corpus Christi procession at OLP will be held June 8. The route and time will be chosen to attract parishioners and witness to others. The route may include the "Muskie" and finish in the church parking lot. After the Mass, procession, there will be hospitality.

Eucharistic Missionary Formation

The team will study the Eucharistic Revival year, watch the videos by Bishop Cozzens and discuss at our next meeting.
